The Community and Regional Resilience Institute (CARRI) and the Natural Hazards Center are organizing a workshop on resilience, which is scheduled to take place just prior to the annual Hazards Workshop, on July 14. This one-day workshop will involve presentations and group discussions on a variety of topics, including resilience in the natural environment and ecosystems; the built environment and infrastructures; health and mental health; firms, markets, and regional economies; populations (including social vulnerability) and civil society. The workshop will also focus on approaches to measuring resilience, including indicators, observations, and data collection strategies, as well as on the evaluation of strategies aimed at enhancing disaster resilience.
